anticipated projects happening in Denver

We've always known Denver was an incredible place to live, and sometime in the last few years, the rest of the country seemed to figure it out too. Population has increased by over 10% since 2010, in a report from DenverUrbanism.

As Denver's population and popularity grow, so must the city. The last few years have been filled with exciting developments, as a great city becomes even greater. With numerous projects in the works right now, here is an update on the ever-developing Denver.

1) Lightrail Introduces New Lines

Union Station to Denver International Airport is set to open in late April 2016.

2) Apartment Projects: One Belleview Station, The Den.

One Belleview Station is a 330,000 square-foot office building slated to be finished by fall 2016. The Den is a 325 unit apartment project, anticipated to be open by summer 2016.

3) New Outdoor Music Venue

Ruby Hill Park is looking forward to adding more outdoor music venues to the vibrant Denver music scene. It also aims to be a companion park to the popular Wash Park. The big unveiling is scheduled for July 1, 2017.

4) The Source Gets a Hotel

The hotel has "unconventional rooms," and will also house a yoga/exercise studio, pool, and the tasting room from a ground-floor New Belgium pilot brewery, The Woods.

5) Living Above Whole Foods

Formerly known as 17W, Pivot Denver is a 579-unit

apartment complex joining the LoDo area in spring of 2017.

6) New Collective Workspace

Shift Workspaces is opening a new location is coming in May 2016 - Shift Bannock.

7) SLOANS, New Urban Neighborhood

Previously the site of St. Anthony's Hospital in West Colfax, the area is being redeveloped into SLOANS. Retail and residential will fill the mixed-use space, a growing trend, especially in Denver.

8) The Rebirth of Union Station

One of the last stages of its remodel is a 19-story, 342-unit condominium tower. It will be the first, and only, for-sale housing in popular downtown, and is committed to offering affordable housing.
